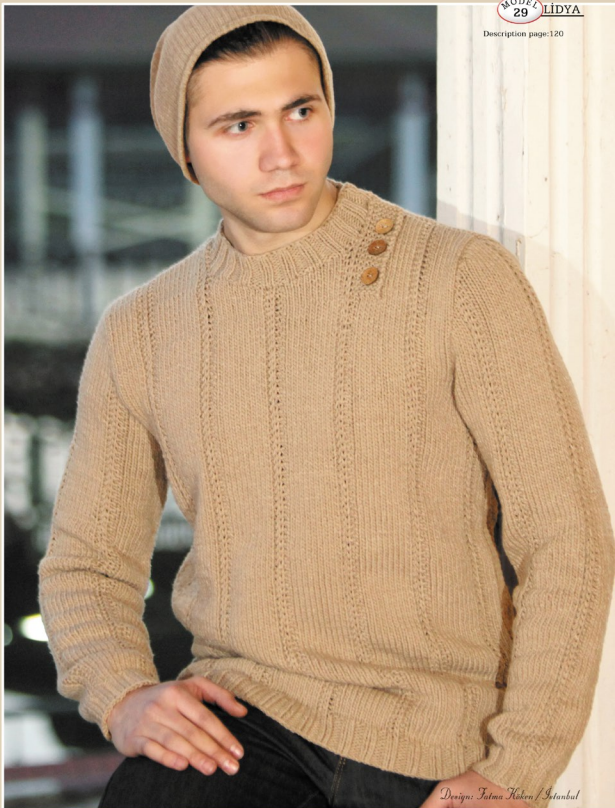

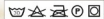

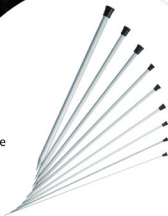

Model: 91 - Beret
Material: Himalaya Mozaik
Color: 56910 - 1 skein
Needle: US 9- 10 (5.5 - 6 mms)

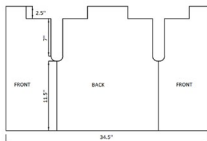


Cast on 8 sts. (K1, yo); rep 7 times, the K1. At the 2nd row work K2, yo through the whole row. When there are 8 increases, work 4.5". Work k1, p1 rib for 2". Bind off all sts.
Sew the sides together

PAGE 03 MODEL 01



Model: 01 - Cardigan
Material: Himalaya Dolphin Baby
Color: 80301 (A) - 2 skeins
80311 (B) - 3 skeins
80317 (C) - 5 skeins
80318 (D) - 1 skein
Hook: US L11 (8 mm)
Zipper



Color Chart:

With C, work 1 row of dc; with D work 1 row of sc, with C work 1 row of dc, with B work 1 row of sc, with A work 1 row of sc, With B work 1 row of sc, with A work 1 row of sc, With B work 1 row of sc

Front & Back: With C make 80 ch, and work 1 row of dc onto the ch row. At the 2nd row work 2dc/rf, 1dc/rb. At the 3rd row work 2dc/rb, 1 dc/rf and finish ribbing. Work 2 sets of 20 front + 40 back + 20 front as shown above according to the color chart.

Front: At the 3rd set with B, work 1 row of sc while working on the armhole shaping also, sl st in each of first 3sts, cross over, leaving 3 sts unworked, turn. Ch 1, sl st in each of first 2 sts, cross over, leaving 2 sts unworked, turn. Then dec 1 st at each side. When there are 4 sts, leave 6 sts at the neck. Work 1 row of dc, and 1 row of sc, fasten off.

Work same as the other front while reversing all shaping.

Back: Follow the same armhole shaping at the back. Sew the shoulders at the last row.

Sleeves: With C, make 22 ch, then work 1 row of dc onto the ch row. At the 2nd row work 2dc/rf, 1dc/rb. At the 3rd row work 2dc/rb, 1 dc/rf and finish ribbing. Work 3 sets as shown above according to the color chart. After the 6th row inc 1 st at every 3 rows. With B work 1 row of sc while also working on the armhole shaping, sl st in each of first 3sts, cross over, leaving 3 sts unworked, turn. Ch 1, sl st in each of first 2 sts, cross over, leaving 2 sts unworked, turn. Then leave 1 st at each side at every row for 14 times. Fasten off.

Neck: Sew shoulders. With C, work 1 row of dc at the body. While working on the 2nd row, work 2dc/rf, 1dc/rb. At the 3rd row work 2dc/rb, 1dc/rf, finish the rib.

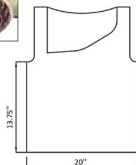
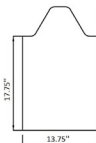
Front pats: Work 4 rows of sc at the neck and the body. Fasten off.

Finishing: Sew sleeves and sides. With the needle work horizontal stripes. Fasten off. Sew a zipper onto front sides.

PAGE 04 MODEL 02



Model: 02 - Pullover
Material: Himalaya Mozaik
Color: 56908 - 5 skeins
Needle: US 10 (6mm)



Cable Pattern: Rows 1 and 3: knit

Row 2 and all even-numbered rows: purl

Row 5: slip 2 to dp needle and hold it at back of the work, k2, k2 from dp needle

Repeat rows 1 through 5 for pattern.

Back: Cast on 52 sts. Work k4, p4 for 6 rows, and work cable with the st sts (at every 6 rows). When the body measures 14", bind off 3 sts, bind off 2 sts, bind 1 st for the armhole shaping. Continue working until armhole measures 6", bind off all sts.

Front: Cast on 52 sts, Work k4, p4 for 6 rows, and work cable with the st sts (at every 6 rows). When the body measures 14", work armhole shaping same as back's. (WS) When the body measures 16.5", work 8 sts, then bind off 3 sts, bind off 3 sts, bind off 1 st, and keep binding off 1 st until 8 sts remain. Work 2.5" with 8 sts then bind off. Work other 8 sts until they reach the shoulders, then bind off these 8 sts too.

Sleeves: Cast on 44 sts, and knit for 18".

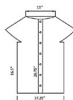
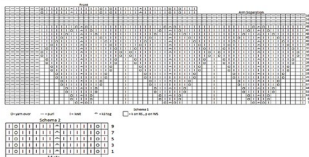
Armhole Shaping: Bind off 3 sts, bind off 2 sts. Then bind off 1 st at every KW row for 10 times. Bind off.

Finishing: Sew the shoulders. Work 1 row of sc around the neck. Sew the sleeves and the sides. At the sleeves' hem, use a hook to work 4 rows of sc while doing decreases according to your wrist size.

PAGE 05 MODEL 03



Model: 03 - Vest
Material: Himalaya Rossi
Color: 81206 - 7 skeins
Needle: US 10 (6mm)
7 buttons



Vest :

Start from the neck down, cast on 61 sts. Work 3 rows of garter sts. On the next row; work 7 garter sts (for the front pat), yo, (k3tog, yo) rep until the last 7 sts, work garter sts with the remaining 7 sts. Purl the sts at the WS row. At the next row follow the pattern 1. After the pattern, work garter st for 3 rows. At the armhole shaping row separate the sts as 40 front, 38 sleeve, 72 back, 38 sleeve, 40 front sts. Bind off the sleeve's sts, while working on the body also cast on 8 sts for the underarm and follow the pattern 2 below for 16.5\"/>

Buttonhole Row:

Work 3sts, bind off 2 sts, work to end of the row.

On the next row, work to bound-off sts, cast on 2 sts, work to end of row.

Buttonhole band: At the front pat; work on the buttonhole rows at the 8 garter sts rows while working on the body

Finishing : Sew buttons to correspondingly to the buttonholes

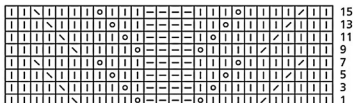

Model: 04 - Pullover
Material: Himalaya Ultra Kaşmir

Needle: US 8 (5mm)

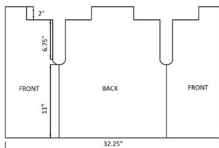
Front: Cast on 64 sts. Work k30, p4, k30 then follow the pattern. When the body measures 14\", bind off 3 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, bind off 2 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, dec 1 st at both sides for the armhole shaping. When the body measures 15.5\", at the 4 purled sts work st st for 4.5\"/>

Back: Cast on 64 sts. Work st st for 14\"/>

Sleeves: Cast on 46 sts. Work k21, p4, k21, then follow the pattern while dec 1st at each side every 4 rows for 10 times. 5.5\"/>

Finishing: Sew sleeves and sides.

Bottom Ending: With a hook work 1 row of sc. Next 2 rows; 3 ch, skip 1sc, 1 dc into each of next2 sc, 1 dc into skipped sc; rep until the end of the row.



Row1: K1, * knit the 2nd st, then knit the 1st st. Remove the sts from the needle; repeat from * to until the end of the row.
Row2: P1, * purl the 2nd st, then purl the 1st st. Remove the sts from the needle; repeat from * to until the end of the row.
Repeat these 2 rows for the pattern.

Armhole and neck shaping: Knit 3/ st st for the front, then bind off 6 sts, and work 74 sts back, bind off 6 sts, work 37 sts front. On the next row; bind off 2 sts, then bind off 1 st from the armhole sides. Work 34 front sts, 68 back sts, 34 front sts for 6.75". At the shoulders bind off 6 sts; 3 times. Keep the remaining sts on the needle, sew the shoulders, work 2" for neck. Work 1 row purl, then work 2" of st. Bind off. Fold the piece inwards and sew it starting from the purled row.

Armhole shaping: Bind off 3 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, bind off 2 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, Then decrease 1 st at the beg of next row at every KW row for 33 times, and bind off all the remaining sts at once.

With G/6 numbered hook work sc starting from one neck line's end until the other end. Skip 12 sc at the neckline, and work sc until the hemline. *At the 3rd row work sc starting from the hemline until the neck (until the skipped sts), and at the last sc turn without knitting, skip 1sc, work sc until the hemline*; rep from * to * until there are 7 rows, and follow the same steps at the other side. On the next row: work sc around the cardigan's edge

Row 1: k2, (p2tog)3 times, * yo, (k1, yo) 5 times, (p2tog) 6 times; repeat from * until the last 4sts,(yo,k1) 3 times, k2.
Row 2 and all even numbered rows: purl.
Rows 3 and 5: knit.
Row 7: repeat row 1
Repeat rows 1 through 5 for the pattern.

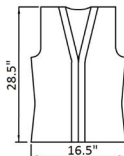
Back: With B, cast on 90 sts. (k2, p2) rib for 6.25". Work st st for 11". Repeat the same sleeve shaping as front's. Knit for 6", and bind off all sts.

Finishing: Sew the shoulders together leaving 12.5" of neck gap. Sew side and sleeve seams.

PAGE 10 MODEL 08



Model: 08 – Women's Vest
Material: Himalaya Yakamoz
Color: 56019 – 5 skeins
Needle: US 4 (3.5 mm)
5 buttons



Front and Back: Cast on 238 sts, work (k2, p2) rib for 2.5". Then purl 3sts,* work garter sts for 2 sts, pass the 2 sts onto the left needle again, wrap the yarn around 2sts , pass them to the right needle again, purl 3; repeat from *to end. At the reverse side, work each stitch as it appears. At the 20th pattern, dec 1st at the 12th and 36th motifs every 2 rows once until motifs sts are finished. When the piece measures 20.5", work 48sts at the front, bind off 12 sts for armhole, 98sts at the back, bind off 12 sts for armhole, 48sts at the front. Then continue working on the front sides. Dec 1st at the armhole's sides every row for 6 times for the armhole shaping. When the piece measures 18.5", bind off 1 st at the front's sides every 4 rows until 23 sts remain. When the piece measures 28", bind off all sts.
Repeat the same armhole shaping as before at the back also. When the piece measures 28" bind off all sts.

Buttonhole Row:

Work 3sts, bind off 2 sts, work until the end of the row.

On the next row, work to bound-off sts, cast on 2 sts, work until the end of row.

Buttonhole band: At the right front band; work a buttonhole row once every 20 sts at the 10 th row while working on the collar

Finishing : Sew the shoulders

Collar: With RS facing, pull out 250 sts and knit evenly along right front, from the back and along left front . Work k2, p2 rib for 12 rows. Bind off.

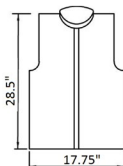
Armhole band: Pull out 90 sts from around the armhole, work k2, p2 rib for 8 rows. Bind off.

Sew buttons to correspondent buttonholes.

Model: 09 – Men's Vest
Material: Himalaya Yakamoz
Color: 56019 – 5 skeins
Needle: US 4 (3.5mm)
6 buttons



Front & Back: Cast on 238 sts, work k2,p2 rib for 2.5". Then purl 3sts,* work garter sts for 2 sts, pass the 2 sts onto the left needle again, wrap the yarn around 2sts , pass them to the right needle again, purl 3sts; repeat from *to end. At the reverse side, work each stitch as it appears. When the piece measures 20.5" knit 53 sts at the front, bind off 12 sts for the armhole, knit 108sts at the back, bind off 12 sts for the armhole, knit 53 sts at the front. Then continue working on the front sides.

Armhole and Neck Shaping: Dec 1st at the armhole's sides every row for 6 times for the armhole shaping

When the piece measures 23.5", bind off 3sts at the front side at every row for the neck shaping until 23sts remain. When the piece measures 28.5" bind off all sts.

Repeat the same armhole shaping as before at the back also. When the piece measures 28.5" bind off all sts.

Buttonhole Row:

Work 3sts, bind off 2 sts, work until the end of the row.

On the next row, work to bound-off sts, cast on 2 sts, work until the end of row.

Buttonhole band: At the right front band; work a buttonhole row once every 26 sts at the 10 th row while working on the front band.

Finishing : Sew the shoulders

Front bands: With RS facing, pull out 136 sts from the front side, work k2, p2 rib for 14 rows. Bind off all sts.

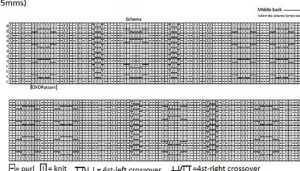
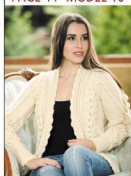

Sleeves: Cast on 54 sts, work k1, p1 rib for 4". Then work p3, (k8, p4, k4, p4) 2 times, k8, p3. Work oxo pattern (see the schema also) at the k8 sts, and work cable pattern at the 4 knitted sts. After the 8 oxo patterns, at the back row slip 1st so as to have 4 slipped sts at the left and 4 slipped sts at the right. Thus the number of the purled sts of the center will be increased. Inc 1 st at the both sides at every 2 rows. When the piece measures 13.5", begin armhole shaping. Bind off 3 sts at both sides, bind off 2 sts at both sides, bind off 2 sts at both sides at every KW until 20 sts remain, then bind off all sts.

Neck: Sew the shoulders. Pick up sts starting from one of the front hemline and continue until the end of the other front's hemline. Work 1 st for 8 rows. On the next row, insert the needle into the 1st row, draw up 1 st and knit with next st on the needle; repeat this step for every st until end of the row. Purl for 1 row. Repeat last 10 rows of st. On the next row, insert the needle into the 1st row of the 10 rows, draw up 1 st and knit with next st on the needle; repeat this step for every st until end of the row and at the same time bind off the sts while working on this row.

Finishing: Sew the sleeves onto the body. Sew the sleeve's sides and side seams. Work with 4 sts to make a 393" long cord, and crossbreed it at every oxo.

Front: Make 38ch with a hook. Work tunisian simple stitch pattern for 36". Then begin armhole shaping.

Armhole and Neck Shaping: work the same armhole shaping as the back's. When the body measures 45" bind off 8sts at the neck side, bind off 3sts at the neck side, bind off 2sts at the neck side, work for 3 rows without binding off. Then fasten off all sts.

Sleeves: Make 36ch with a hook. Work tunisian simple stitch pattern for 1". Inc 1 st at both sides once every 1" for 15 times. 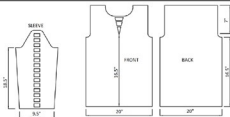

Sleeves: Cast on 48 sts. Work k1, p1 rib for 6 rows. *While starting the st st bind off 12 rows from the center and cast on 12 sts on the turning row*; rep from * to * every 0.5" while increasing 1 st at both ends for 12 times. When there are 12 bands start binding off 3 sts, then 2 sts, then 1 st for the armhole shaping, and continue binding off until 17 sts remain.

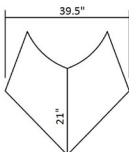

Step 2: Wrap the yarn around the hook and pull through, keeping this loop to a normal size. Hold the first lengthened chain separate from the thread leading to the new loop.

Step 3: Insert the hook under this separate thread, wrap the yarn around the hook, and pull through the first loop.

Step 4: Wrap the yarn around the hook again and pull through both of the loops to complete the knot.

Repeat these steps with sc to create a pattern.

Puff (ps): A puff is normally a group of three or more half doubles, joined at both top and bottom.

Step 1: * Wrap the yarn around the hook, insert the hook where required, draw through a loop, repeat from * to end 4 times in the same place. Wrap the yarn around the hook again, and pull through all of the loops on the hook.

Step 2: often, one chain is worked to close the puff.

Shawl

Make 8 ch, sl st into first ch to form a ring.

Row 1: (2dc, 2sk, 2dc) into ring, turn.

Row 2: 3ch (count as 1dc), dc into next dc, 2sk, 1sc in closing sc of next sk, 2sk, dc into next 2dc, turn.

Row 3: 3ch (count as 1dc), dc into next dc, (2sk, 1sc in closing sc of next sk) twice, 2sk, dc into next 2dc, turn.

Continue working in this way increasing 2sk at every row. Work 40 rows. At the 41th row, leave 8 sk at the center for the neck and continue working one side. Dec 2sk at neck's edge until 2 sk remain, fasten off.

Repeat these steps for the other piece

Bordure: Work the pattern below on the both edges of the shawl

*Sc, 12ch, 1 ps, 4ch, 1sc into bottom of ps, 12ch; repeat from * along two edge. Fasten off.

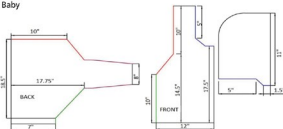

Cast 29sts on the increased side, and connect this part with the 2nd piece's increased side, and knit for 9.5". Centralise the sts, knit 27sts, K3tog, knit the 27sts, repeat the decrease done at the center once every 4 rows for 4 times. At every KW repeat binding off 4 times. Sew the pieces with blindstitch at the KW.

Finishing

Sewing: Sew from the red lined sides, then the green lined sides, and then lastly sew the sleeve's hems. Sew the hood onto the body.

With a hook work sc for 4 rows around the sleeve hems

The hood can be accessorised by sewing a piece of appropriate fabric.

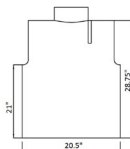

Sleeves: Cast on 43sts, work k2, p2 rib for 2". Work k7, p1,yo,slip 1st, p1, k10, p1, yo, slip 1st, p1, k10, p1, yo, slip 1st, p1,k7. Inc 1 st once every 6 rows at the ends until the piece measures 12". When the piece measures 21", bind off 5 sts at the beg of next 2 rows, dec 1 st at the beg of every row until 15 sts remain. Round 1: (1 puff st, 3ch, 1 puff st, 4ch) four times, sl st into top of 1st puff st.



Round 2: With B, 3ch (count as 1dc), 3dc into next 3ch-sp, (4dc, 3ch, 4dc) into next 4ch-sp, [4 dc into next 3ch-sp, (4dc, 3ch, 4dc) into next 4ch-sp] three times, sl st into 3rd of the 3ch at beg of round.

Round 3: With A, work sc into each dc and work 3sc into 3ch-sp at the corners, sl st into 1st sc.

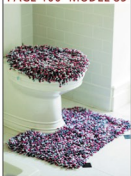
Round 4: With C, 3ch, work dc into each sc while making 3ch at the corners

Round 5: Repeat round 3. Fasten off.

Connect all the motifs and with A follow the 2nd pattern. Then fasten off.

Model: 85 – Toilet Covers

Material: Himalaya Dolphin Junior Colors

Color: 81004 – 12 skeins

Needle: US 10 (6mm)

Fur stitch

Row 1 (WS): Knit

Row 2: *K1, k1, keeping st on left-hand needle, bring yf, pass the yarn over to the left thumb to make a loop (approx 11/2in / 4 cm), yb and knit this st again, slipping st off the needle, yo and pass the 2 sts just worked over this loop (1 loop made = ML); rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

Row 3: Knit.

Row 4: K2, * ML, k1; rep from * until the end.

Rep these 4 rows.

Cover

Cast on 30 sts and follow pattern. At the same time, inc 1 st at both side until there are 40 sts. When the piece measures 13 " from beg, dec 1 st at both side every-two rows for 4 times. Then, bind off 2 sts at both sides until 20sts remain. Bind off all sts at once.

Contour rug

Cast on 65 sts and work on the pattern for 4.5". On the next row; knit 25sts, bind off 15 sts, knit 25sts. Work each 25 sts separately, bind off 2 sts at the inner sides. When the piece measures 12 " from th beg, bind off all sts.

Bath mat

Cast on 65sts and follow the pattern. When the knitting measures 40" bind off all sts.

Note: Readymade toilet covers are used for the measurements.

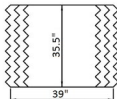

Material: Himalaya Joyful Colors

Color: 80207 – 8 skeins

Needle: US 11 (8 mm)



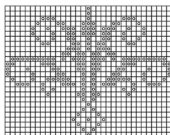
Blanket: Cast on 76sts and work garter sts. Starting from the 1st row inc 1st at both KW; rep for 6 times. Bind off 1st (same way as the increases) for 6 times to form a slice. Repeat until there are 8 slices.

Sides (4 pieces): Cast on 22sts. Work 8 garter sts, K6, 8 garter sts. Bind off 1sts at one end while inc 1st at the other end; rep for 6 times. Inc at the decreased side, dec at the increased side. Work cable (slip next 3sts onto cable needle and hold at the back of the work, knit next 3sts from left-hand needle, then knit sts from the cable needle) the central st st sts every 6 rows. When there are 8 slices at one side bind off all sts. Make 4 pieces, and sew the pieces together with blanket. (2 pieces for one side, 2 pieces for other side)

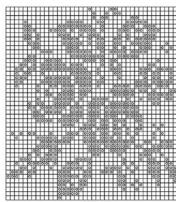
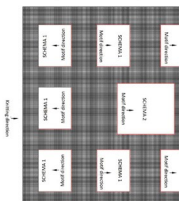

Repeat row 2 for the pattern.

Blanket

Ch 388, make 385 dc, and work dc for 15 rows. Then, work 39 dc, 159 large mesh ground pattern, 39 dc. Repeat this for 12 rows. 12 rows after follow the 1st pattern. See the 3rd pattern for the locations.

Motif pattern

Make 4ch, sl st into 1st ch to form a ring.

Round 1: 1 sc, (1hdc, 1dc, 1tr, 3ch, 1tr, 1dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, 1tr, 3ch, 1tr, 1dc, 1hdc) into ring, sl st in first sc of the round.

Round 2: 5ch, 1 dc in same sc, 1dc in next hdc, 1dc in next dc, 1dc in next tr, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in next 3ch-ps, 1dc in next tr, 1dc in next dc, 1dc in next hdc, 1 dc in sc, 3 ch, 1 dc in same sc, 1dc in next hdc, 1dc in next dc, 1dc in next tr, (3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in next 3ch-ps, 1dc in next tr, 1dc in next dc, 1dc in next hdc, 1 dc in sc, 1 ss in 3rd of 5ch at the beginning of the round.

Round 3: 3ch, (2dc, 3ch, 3dc) in 5ch-sp, 2ch, skip 2dc, dc in next 3dc, 2 ch, skip 2dc, ((3dc, 3ch, 3dc) in next 3ch-sp, 2ch, skip 2dc, dc in next 3dc, 2 ch, skip 2dc) 3 times, 1 ss in 3rd of 3ch at the beginning of the round. Fasten off.

Finishing

After connecting the motif according to the size required, with 80310 work 1 row of dc. Then change to 80315 and work another row of dc. Fasten off. Make tassels at the edges.





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
